

Legal structure change

Retina Implant assumes new role as corporation

Reutlingen, Germany – Medical technology provider Retina Implant GmbH is now a corporation. The legal structure change is designed to groom the company for future expansion-related investments. A date for an initial public offering has not been set.

The outcome of a shareholders' general meeting in late July led to the decision to become a corporation. The current chairman of the supervisory board is Eberhart Zrenner, MD, PhD, medical director of the University Eye Clinic in Tuebingen, Ger-

many. Management of the company will stay the same.

The company is building an active subretinal chip to enable people who are blind and have certain forms of retinal degeneration to regain some lost sight. ■
